Let's get your bar fridge up and running!

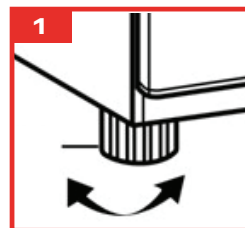
Welcome to your new Hoover bar fridge! We hope that this product brings you many years of enjoyment.

Comprehensive installation instructions, diagrams and safety advice are provided in the supplied instruction manual.

CAUTION! The unit is heavy - transport it with care! To avoid back or other injury, we recommend you ask someone for help or use a mechanical aid when moving it.

Installation

- Before you start installing the bar fridge, wipe the interior surfaces and accessories with a damp cloth to remove any dust from transit and storage. Dry thoroughly.
- The fridge is designed for freestanding use. The floor must be strong, sturdy and level – adjust the levelling feet, if necessary (Fig. 1). Avoid areas where the fridge would be exposed to direct sunlight, heat, extremely cold ambient temperatures or excessive moisture and high humidity. Installing it in the coolest area of the room will save energy consumption and running costs.
- Avoid areas where the fridge would be exposed to direct sunlight, heat, extreme cold ambient temperatures or excessive moisture and high humidity. Installing it in the coolest area of the room will save energy consumption and running costs. Allow at least 10 cm clear space at the back and sides of the unit, and 70 cm above, so air can circulate freely around the freezer.
- Leave enough space to access and open the doors and drawers. Allow at least 10 cm clear space at the back of the appliance and 30 cm at the top so air can circulate freely around the fridge. Also ensure it is placed at least 50 cm from heat sources and at least 5 cm from electric ovens.
- For detailed installation instructions, please consult the manual.
- Before plugging in your new fridge, let it stand upright for at least 2 hours. This will allow the refrigerant gases to settle into the compressor and reduce the possibility of a malfunction.



Connection

- The refrigerator compartment is suitable for short-term storage of all your fresh food. You can adjust the position of the glass shelf to suit your storage requirements.
- The door balconies on the door offer ample storage space for condiments, spreads and drink containers of different size.
- The freezer compartment is designed for long-term storage (up to three months) of frozen food.
- The door swing direction of this bar fridge can be reversed. See pages 17-18 of the instruction manual for detailed instructions.

Controls

- This refrigerator has an adjustable thermostat in the main compartment, so you can adjust the temperature of the fridge.
- There are eight temperature levels for this fridge, from 0 (off) to 7 (coldest).
- To adjust the temperature, turn the temperature control dial clockwise towards 7 to lower the temperature and anticlockwise towards 1 to increase the temperature inside the fridge compartment (Fig. 2).
- A middle setting from 3-5 should be appropriate for everyday use.
- When making ice cubes in the freezer, or after you have added larger quantities of unfrozen food, set the control temporarily to 7 for fast freezing.
